INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

TO THE MEMBERS OF RANIPET DISTRICT MINERAL FOUNDATION TRUST

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of **Ranipet District Mineral Foundation Trust(hereinafter called the "Trust")**, which comprise the balance sheet as at March 31, 2022, Receipt and Payment Account and the Income and Expenditure Account for the year ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion and to the best of information and according to the explanations given to us, the financial statements for the year ending 31-03-2022 a true and fair view of the statement of affairs.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) issued by ICAI.
